

UPPER OXFORD TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
JUNE 2, 2008

The Upper Oxford Township Planning Commission held its regular monthly meeting at the township building, 1185 Limestone Road, Russellville, PA at 7:30 P.M. on Monday, June 2, 2008.

Members present: Christine Nibouar, Sam Reyburn, David Underwood, Harold Bryson, Karl Herr and Ron Ragan, township engineer.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by the Chairman, Christine Nibouar.

MINUTES – Motion was made by Harold Bryson, seconded by Sam Reyburn and carried to approve the May 5, 2008 Minutes. MOTION CARRIED

Karl Herr gave a summary of the last Oxford Regional Planning meeting that he attended. The discussion revolved around historical properties in the areas. Upper Oxford Township only had one listed which was McDowel Mill on Route 896. Anything over 50 years is considered “historic”. Christine wanted to know if having a property declared historic gives the township control over the property. Frances Reyburn told her that the township does not have control.

SURVEY – The Planning Commission discussed and filled out the recent survey.

ZONING AND SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE CHANGES – Were handed out to the Planning Commission who will take them home and review them this month and will be discussed at the next month’s meeting. Additionally, Charles Fleischmann will incorporate the changes into a document and send out to the Planning Commission Members.

WORK SESSION – The next advertised Board of Supervisors work session is scheduled for June 23, 2008.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, motion was made by Harold Bryson, seconded by Dave Underwood and carried to adjourn at 9:05 P.M.
